

CITY OF JOSEPH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, July 11, 2019

1. **Call Meeting to Order and Pledge of Allegiance** at 7:00 by Mayor Teresa Sajonia. Attending: Wyatt Baum, City Attorney, Councilors Lisa Collier, Patty Bufford, Pearl Sturm, Marty Hamilton, Mayor Teresa Sajonia, Public Works Levi Tickner, and City Recorder Belinda Buswell, recording.
2. **REPORTS:**
 - A. **Police Report** – Sheriff Steve Rogers – (Appendix A) No one from Sheriff’s office to deliver report. Mayor Sajonia wanted it noted that someone from the Sheriff’s office is supposed to attend the council meeting and wanted it noted. It is part of their contract. The report shows 240 hours of patrolling. There is a call in to meet with the Sheriff’s department to clarify expectations of the contract.
 - B. **Library Report** – Eric Shoudel –Presented Library report (Appendix B)
 - C. **Fire Chief Report** – Chief Jeffrey Weeks – Presented Fire report (Appendix C)
 - D. **Administrative Report** – Larry Braden – Presented Administrative report (Appendix D)
 - E. **Public Works Report** – Levi Tickner – Busy month in June working with EPA, DEQ, with the lake barrels, obtained rates from other cities for comparison, a lot of catch up on maintenance from past years, graded roads, had one leak. It’s been pretty busy.
 - E. **Committee Reports** –
 - **Community Center Committee** – Patty Bufford/Raider Heck – Raider and I have met and talked about what’s completed and what’s left to do. Raider – The double doors on the entrance haven’t closed without overlapping in ten years. We are hoping to develop some systems for inventory and tracking. Also have a lower rental fee with a considerable higher deposit. We hope to be done with the inside soon and focus on the outside. New blinds, flooring is going in, there is also a kickstand on the door so no more rock to hold the door open. We are still looking for volunteers to help side the building. Councilor Lisa Collier asked if security cameras would be put up.
 - **Zoning Ordinance Review Task Force Committee** – Raider Heck – We are still plodding through and it is not exciting but there are things that are being addressed and our hopes are to have some suggestions for the council.
 - **Main Street Committee** – Mayor Sajonia – Adrian’s last day was June 28th, so Judy is our only main street committee. Raider Heck – There has been some volunteers that have done some work on the boxes where they work and others where they don’t. I watched Judy and Adrian moved a large rock by the Dog Spot.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT – ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA**
 - a) **Kathy Bingham** – (406 E Third) One of your committees has been to have a website committee but I see it is no more. Are we going to have a new website? Mayor Sajonia – I would like to say it will be up and running by September.

4 NEW BUSINESS

- a) **Declaration – Chieftain as the Newspaper of Record** -Motion was made by Councilor Bufford that the Chieftain will be the Newspaper of Record, 2nd by Councilor Lisa Collier. Vote passed unanimously.
- b) **WLRFPD Contract – Jeff Weeks** – The contract was increased by 3% to \$37,264.11. A motion was made by Councilor Hamilton to approve the increase in the contract, 2nd by Councilor Sturm. Vote passed unanimously.
- c) **Resolution 2019-06 – Approving Taxes for 2019-2020 Fiscal year-** Motion was made by Councilor Bufford to approve Resolution 2019-06 to impose taxes in the amount of \$2.9867 per \$1000 of assessed value for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 2nd by Councilor Sturm, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- d) **Resolution 2019-07 – Adopting Budget for 2019-2020 Fiscal year-** Motion was made by Councilor Hamilton to approve Resolution 2019-07, 2nd by Councilor Sturm, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- e) **Resolution 2019-08 – Declaring the City’s Election to Receive State Revenues for 2019-2020 Fiscal year-** Motion was made by Councilor Bufford to approve Resolution 2019-08, 2nd by Councilor Hamilton, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- f) **Resolution 2019-09 – Increasing Monthly Water Rate to \$32.60-** Motion was made by Councilor Sturm to approve Resolution 2019-09, 2nd by Councilor Bufford, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- g) **Resolution 2019-10 – Increasing Monthly Sewer Rate to \$31-** Motion was made by Councilor Bufford to approve Resolution 2019-10, 2nd by Councilor Sturm, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- h) **Resolution 2019-11 – Increasing Street Project Fee to \$10-** Motion was made by Mayor Sajonia to approve Resolution 2019-11, 2nd by Councilor Bufford, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- i) **Resolution 2019-12 – Creating a Marijuana Sub Fund-** Motion was made by Councilor Hamilton to approve Resolution 2019-12, 2nd by Councilor Bufford, vote failed 3-1. Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- j) **Resolution 2019-13 – Creating a County Hotel/Motel Tax Sub Fund-** Motion was made by Councilor Hamilton to approve Resolution 2019-13, 2nd by Councilor Bufford, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- k) **Resolution 2019-14 – Visa User Fee-** Resolution was tabled in order to make clarifying changes. It will be readdressed at the August meeting. A motion was made to approve Resolution 2019-04, 2nd by Councilor Sturm. Comment by Steve Tool regarding the word Visa, Raider Heck asked if it was \$3 or 3%. Mayor Sajonia asked the council to table the resolution to correct typo and remove Visa. Resolution will be readdressed at the August meeting. Vote was 4-0 to table with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.
- l) **Resolution 2019-15 – NSF Fee-** Motion was made by Councilor Bufford to approve Resolution 2019-15, 2nd by Councilor Hamilton, vote passed 4-0 with Councilor Lisa Collier recusing herself from the vote.

4. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a) **Wyatt Baum** – Facciuto Conditional Use Permit (CUP) Update – Wyatt presented information from the zoning ordinance that states the business is not “existing”. There was discussion with the applicant’s attorney Zac Hostetter as to the ability of the council to make conditions of approval for the CUP as stated in Section 6.020 of the 2009 Zoning ordinance and Wyatt agreed that the council does have the right as allowed with Home Rule to make conditions. Mayor Sajonia mentioned that the land use plan states that industrial zone is supposed to increase economic opportunities for the city. She feels that the cart is way before the horse and that the council needs to follow their land use plan and zoning ordinances. Councilor Hamilton added that he can feel for the applicants but the council needs to stick to the land use plan. After the discussion, a motion was made to deny David & Victoria Facciuto CUP by Councilor Hamilton, 2nd by Councilor Sturm. Vote passed 4-1 with Mayor Sajonia, Councilors Sturm, Bufford, and Hamilton voting aye to deny, Councilor Lisa Collier voting aye against denial. Motion carried to deny the CUP 4-1.

5. CONSENT AGENDA

The items on the Consent Agenda are considered routine and all will be adopted by one motion unless a councilor member or a person in the audience requests, before the vote on the motion, to have any item considered separately. If any item is removed from the Consent Agenda, the Mayor will indicate when it will be discussed.

a) ***City Council Minutes Regular Meeting June 6, 2019***

Motion was made by Councilor Bufford to approve the consent agenda, 2nd by Councilor Hamilton. Vote passed unanimously.

6. STAFF ITEMS

- a) Larry Braden – I would like Belinda to talk about the rate comparison she completed.
- b) Belinda Buswell – I emailed all the cities and did analysis to show the cities with comparable populations throughout the state and their rates. This shows we are at the lower end. Chris Bullet Did you ask what the gallons were. Belinda commented that the gallon average for the cities were at 3,000 gallons for the fee and the City of Joseph is at 5,000 so with the adjustment down to 3,000 we are still at the bottom of the scale. Donna Bronson- Are we still going to be charged the other fees, the \$5 and \$6. Councilor Hamilton mentioned that the rate increase will assist us in obtaining grants. Mayor Sajonia stated it is a lot of years of not raising the rates that has gotten into this situation now where we are forced to raise the rates to keep the livability of our city. Donna Bronson asked about the bubbles she sees in her water sometimes. Public Works supervisor Levi Tickner explained the bubbles are the result of backflow turbulence. It doesn’t affect the quality of the water but can esthetically cause change. It may be bubbles, discoloration, or look cloudy. Kathy Bingham- Can we compare how we fit into Wallowa County?

7. COUNCILORS’ and MAYOR’S ITEMS

- a) **Councilor Tanya Collier** – Absent
- b) **Councilor Lisa Collier** – Is any paving going to happen up past the lake highway because I have three ways to get there but there isn’t a good one.
- c) **Councilor Patty Bufford** – None
- d) **Councilor Zacharias** – Resigned-letter was submitted to City Hall effective immediately
- e) **Councilor Sturm** – None-Left early
- f) **Councilor Hamilton** – I did notice there is a bunch of wood piled up on our city street by the Folk School I thought maybe Larry could address and have them put it on their property because it could be a public hazard.
- g) **Mayor Sajonia** – I have felt a bit of frustration in regards to our ordinance enforcement. You are probably going to hear from me as a citizen to file complaint forms because we had a hard time

passing the contract for the last Sheriff's contract. I just want everybody to know I have a bit of a problem with them. As far as the contract goes, I can say listen you aren't following your contract. Raider Heck-We are spending \$9000 a month and going into our peak season of the year when our city is on display and we are supposed to get 60 hours a week of police force not 6 calls, or 13 calls, but 60 hours. Belinda Buswell-403 E 5th. I am concerned that I have seen City staff have to approach residences to deliver code enforcement and the Sheriff staff in the vicinity stayed back. I feel that can create a precarious situation and create an unsafe situation and I think that shouldn't be tolerated. Larry Braden Like Raider said, I write the checks and that is a lot of money for the City. Raider Heck- I am just going to ask for citizens to go get a copy of the contract. Kathy Bingham- I did make a complaint this week about multiple RVs is there anything being done with that. Larry Braden-We did go out and look at that, I just haven't had time this week to deal with it. That particular residence has been a problem in the past. Code enforcement is not being done.

9. PUBLIC COMMENT

- a) **Donna Bronson**- We had that problem when we had the carnival. We just parked behind them. I don't see that much over there I'm across the street.

10. MOTION FOR ADJOURNMENT Motion was made to adjourn by Councilor Bufford, 2nd by Councilor Hamilton. Motion passed unanimously at 9:01pm.

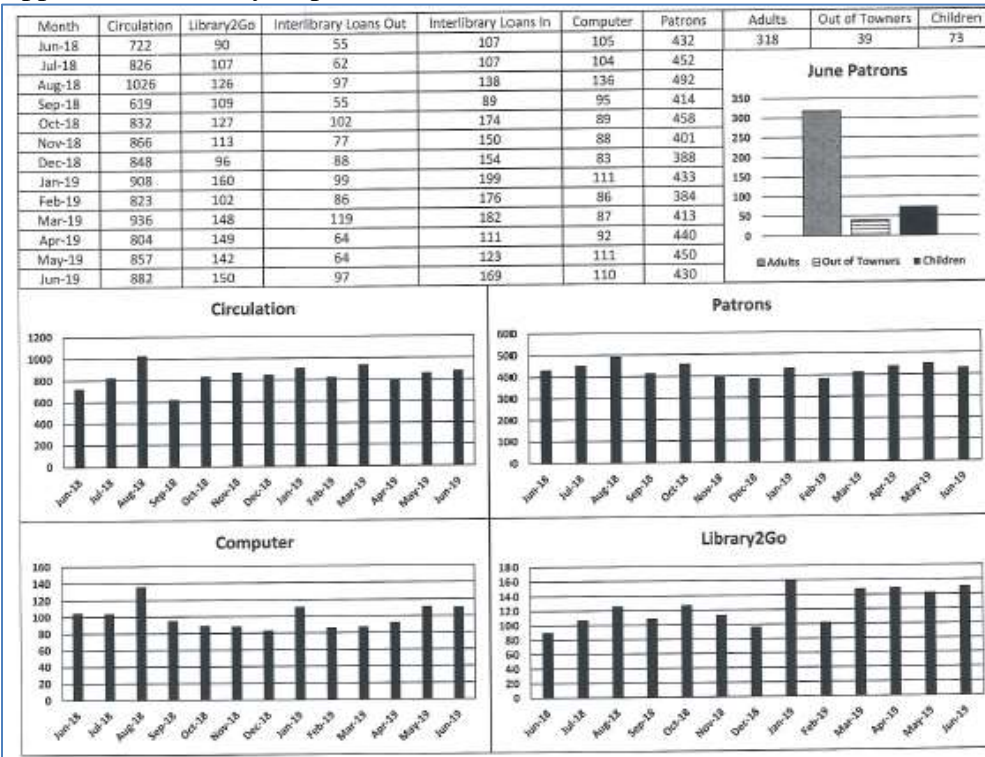

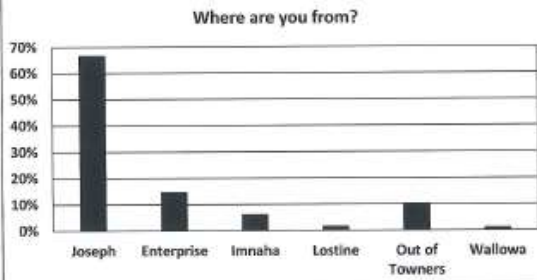

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT
July 11, 2019

I was appointed budget officer in April 2019. In June, the City Council voted to make me the sole purchasing agent for the City of Joseph. Since then, I have been developing spending protocols and working on putting them into action with City staff.

A good portion of my time in the last month have been working on the City of Joseph's Street Paving Project. On June 11, I publicly opened bids for this project. On June 20th, I awarded the bid to Hampton Paving from LaGrande, Oregon. I am pleased to report that work will begin on August 8 and take about six weeks to complete. The majority of my time on this project has been spent on financing. The City of Joseph is working with Community Bank to make this project possible, putting together a loan package that works for the City. In the later part of June, I also applied for a \$100,000.00 grant through ODOT to help with the City's paving needs. Status on that grant is pending.

The last weekend in June we finally finished grading all gravel roads in the City and made ready for dust abatement, which will take place July 18th.

The City of Joseph's Waste Water Plant upgrade is moving along. I attended a one-stop meeting in LaGrande with our Engineers to be presented with financial options for the New Waste Water Plant.

I have had numerous meetings this month with Joseph residents discussing and solving various issues. Resolving disagreements between neighbors, City right-of-way issues, utility issues. My favorite part of this job is talking to and helping our City Residents.

I am continuing to develop systems and protocols for the City of Joseph Staff as a whole. We are still learning who each other and and figuring out how to effectively work together for the benefit of the City.
