**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY FEE SCHEDULE TO ESTABLISH PERMIT
FEES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS AND STREET CLOSURES**

WHEREAS, the City of Joseph deems it necessary to establish a permitting process for special events held within city limits; and

WHEREAS, events requiring closure of city streets necessitate additional administrative oversight and coordination with the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously established a comprehensive fee schedule via Resolution No. 2025-10; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the fees established herein are reasonable and necessary to recover the costs associated with processing such permits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSEPH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Definition. For the purpose of this Resolution, a “Special Event” is defined as any organized activity, gathering, or occurrence held within city limits that is likely to generate significantly increased pedestrian or vehicular traffic, or requires the use of city resources or public rights-of-way. Special Events shall not include funeral services, celebrations of life, or private parties held on private property (such as birthdays or graduation).

Section 2. The following fees are hereby established and required for any special event held within the City of Joseph:

- Special Event Permit: \$150.00 per event
- Special Event Permit with Street Closure: \$200.00

Section 3. These fees shall be added to the existing city fee schedule, as described in Resolution No. 2025-10, and shall supersede any conflicting fees previously established for these specific services.

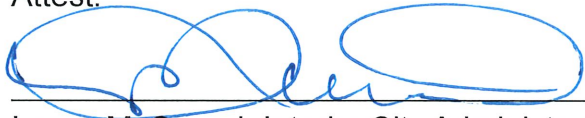
Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage.
