

Permit for Open Burning

Allowable open burning of unconfined burning piles shall be limited to the hours of six (6) a.m. to seven (7) p.m.

o person shall cause, allow to be initiated, or allow to be maintained, any open burning of any material except for those as follows:
 A. The burning of dry yard debris and agricultural waste. Unconfined burning piles shall be located in an area free of combustible materials surrounding the burning pile and the area shall be of sufficient size so as to prevent the kindling of any secondary fire. All unconfined burning piles shall be constantly supervised. Suppression equipment, including water, shovels, rakes, or any such items shall be required for the extinguishing of the unconfined burning piles or additional secondary fire and shall be readily available during burning. B. Fires set or permitted by any public agency when such a fire is set or permitted in the performance of its official duty.
ROHIBITED MATERIALS
 A. Department of Environmental Quality Prohibited Material. There shall be no open burning of materials which are expressly prohibited by law, and/or which emit dense or toxic smoke, or noxious odors. a. Any garbage or any household trash. b. Plastic of any kind. c. Wire insulation. d. Automobile parts. e. Asphalt, petroleum products, or petroleum treated products. f. Any rubber product. g. Animal remains, or animal or vegetable matter resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking, or service of food. h. Any other material which normally emits dense smoke or noxious odors. i. Painted wood or Plywood, or any wood products containing resin or adhesives. j. Treated wood products. k. Wet grass. l. Paper products.
